Meet the Safeguarding Team

The child's needs are paramount, and the needs and wishes of each child, be they baby or infant, or an older child, should be put first, so that every child receives the support they need before a problem escalates. Providing early help is more effective in promoting the welfare of children than reacting later. Early help means providing support as soon as a problem emerges, at any point of a child's life, from the foundation years through to the teenage years DFE 2015.
