Safeguarding - Our school always follow all national and local authority recommended guidelines with regards to any safeguarding issues and the safety of all our children is paramount at all times. A reminder that we need the contact details of at least three emergency contacts. This is a recommendation following a serious case review where a school and the other children services including medical and social welfare services did not have a contact number for a family which led to serious consequences. We will be checking contact numbers over the next few weeks however if you know that you have less than 3 contacts or if your contacts have changed please let our office staff know was soon as possible so that we can amend our records. Thank you for your co-operation.

Attendance and punctuality - 86 children across the school achieved a fantastic 100% attendance last term. This is an outstanding achievement, especially with all the viruses and illnesses that have been going through the school. They were rewarded, in the last week of term, for their outstanding attendance with playing a variety of board games in the Key Stage 2 hall.
