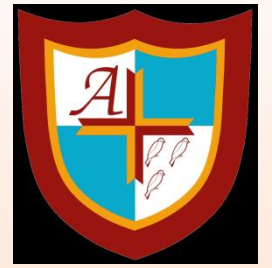

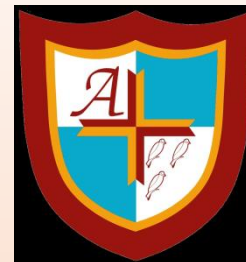

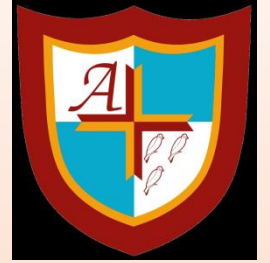

Attendance



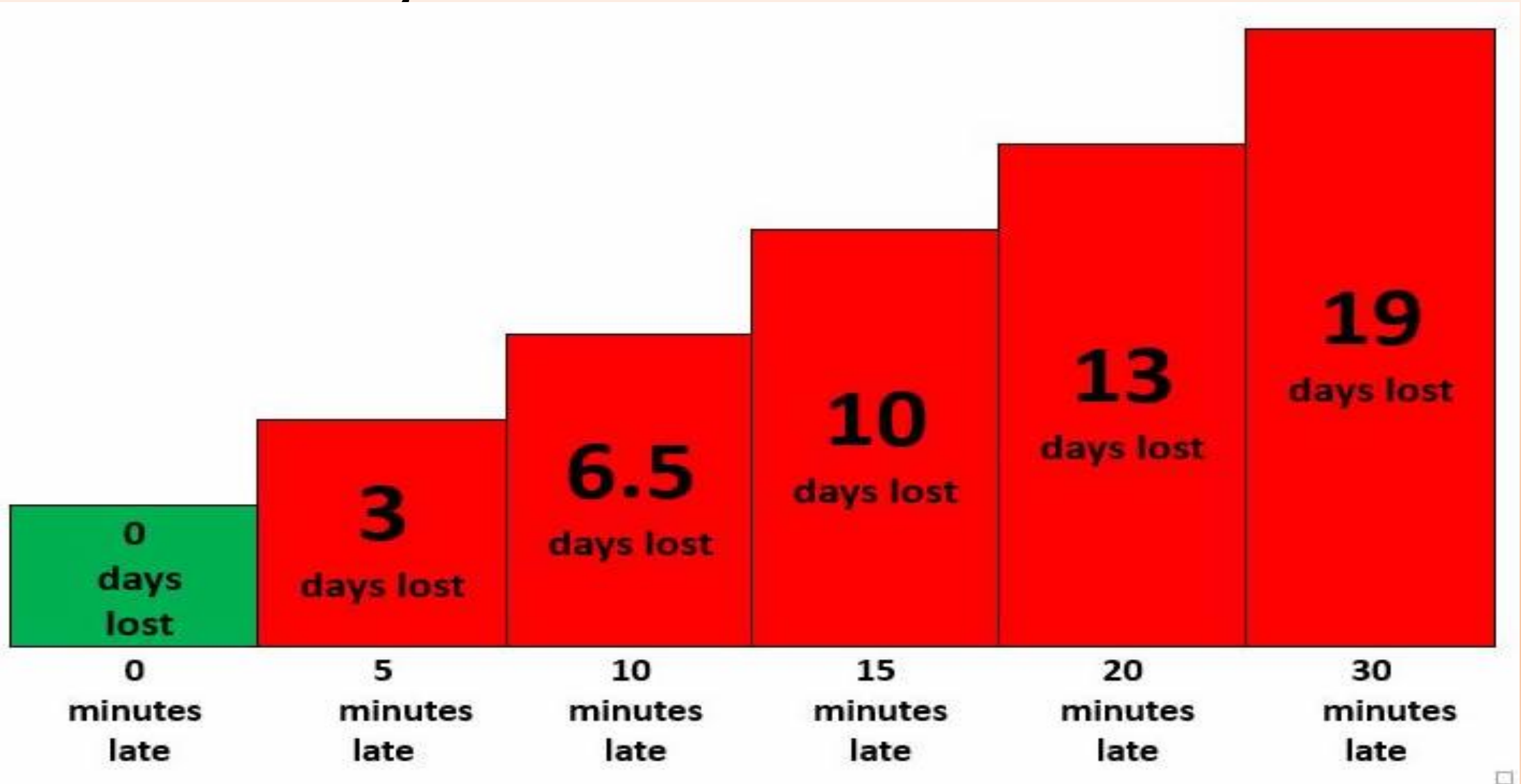
What is expected attendance ?

Year 1 Curriculum

English – basic sentence writing – capital letters, finger spaces and full stops. Plurals adding ‘s’ and ‘-es’. Adding ‘-ed’ and ‘-ing’. Using adjectives. Using because, and or but to extend sentences.

Maths – counting to 100, place value, addition and subtraction to 20, 2D and 3D shape, measurement (including time), multiplication and division, fractions, money .

Science – Materials, Humans and other animals, Plants and Seasonal Change.

RE – Come and See scheme with topics such as Baptism, Advent, Our World.

RSHE – we follow Journey in Love Scheme including body parts

History – Toys, Shopping, Explorers.

Geography – Local Area, Mapping Skills, Seasons and United Kingdom

Art – Colour, Patterns and Shapes, Natural Artwork (Andy Goldsworthy)

DT – Wheels and Axels, Structures, Salads

PSHE – Staying Safe, Healthy Me, Money, First Aid

PE – Fundamental skills, Dance, Gymnastics, Invasion Games, Tennis, Athletics

Phonics

We follow the Little Wandle Phonics scheme.

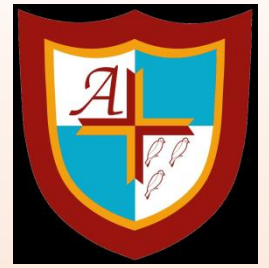
We have a phonics lesson and a guided reading lesson every morning between 9am and 10am.

Reading Books are changed every Monday and Friday.

Every **Friday** we change the Little Wandle reading book. This is a book they have read 3 times as part of a guided reading session in school. They should be more fluent with this book.

Every **Monday** we change the home reading book. This is an unseen book that they haven't practised but is matched to their phonics knowledge.

Please read both of these books at home with your child.

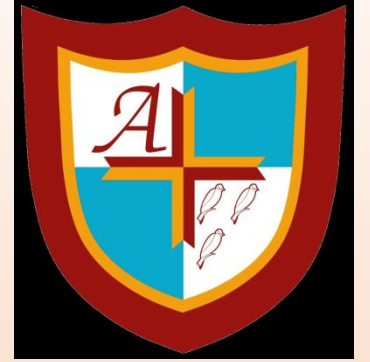
